APPEARANCE

Dark red with vibrant purple hues.

BOUQUET

A generous fruitful nose of red cherry, ripe raspberry, blueberry, dark plum and blackcurrant, sit over a dusting of oak and subtle brown spice of nutmeg, clove and cinnamon.

PALATE

Juicy but tactile. Upfront fruit of raspberry, sweet cherry and plum lead into a creamy milk chocolate mid palate, layered with lightly roasted nuts, smoky toast and a light dusting of cinnamon. The fine line of acidity is complemented by mouth coating tannins that provide the wine with a beautiful feel from start to finish.

14.5%

AGEING POTENTIAL

This wine is made to be enjoyed now while it is fresh, young and vibrant but has the capacity to develop and soften given time in bottle

WINEMAKING

The fruit for this wine was picked on flavour maturity in the vineyard, then fermented for 7-8 days on skins, before being matured in older French and American hogshead barrels. Careful handling from vineyard to bottle preserved the primary fruit flavours we aim for in this wine.
