APPEARANCE

# BOUQUET

An opulent, generous nose dominated with rich dark fruits of ripe plum, cassis and blackberry over milk chocolate, nutmeg, and cinnamon.

# PALATE

Concentrated, black cherry, blueberry and juicy plum combine with milk chocolate, lightly roasted nuts and brown spice to provide a flavoursome palate that is given focus and shape with balanced acidity and structural tannin.

# WINEMAKING

The fruit for this wine was picked on flavour maturity in the vineyard, then fermented for 7-8 days on skins, before being matured in older French and American hogshead barrels. Careful handling from vineyard to bottle preserved the primary fruit flavours we aim for in this wine.
