### BOUQUET

Classic varietal aromas of guava, stinging nettle and passionfruit combine with hints of pineapple, nashi pear and apple.

A polished, focussed palate displaying lime, passionfruit and apple over delicate hints of pineapple and melon, held together with a beautiful line of natural acidity that provides persistence and a clean crisp finish.

# WINEMAKING

The fruit for this vintage was sourced from the cooler region of the Adelaide Hills. The fruit was harvested in the cool of the early mornings to preserve the fresh characteristics and avoid any unwanted phenolics.

The fruit was pressed and drained to stainless steel tanks where it was carefully fermented at cool temperatures for around two weeks, maintaining the fresh fruit flavours and natural acidity.
